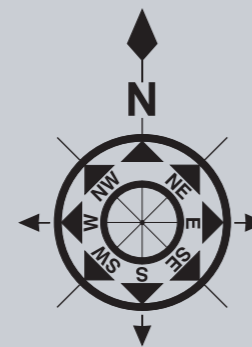

- Stay 500' clear of the Marine Deputy vessel when lights are on. (It's the law.)
- Kite lines can cause serious injury (Stay clear of lines!)
- Please stay back from kiteboard launching areas unless participating.
