



FOOD TRUCK STATEMENT OF USER RESPONSIBILITY

In Conjunction with Picnic Shelter Reservations

All users agree to the following (users are the park renter and the food truck operator):

The users assume the entire responsibility and liability for losses, damages and claims arising out of injury or damage to the user's display, equipment and other property brought onto the premises of the Port facility reserved and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Port from any and all such losses, damages and claims arising out of such use.

Duration of allowed operation is three (3) hours. Only one (1) Food Truck allowed at the Marina Park Picnic Shelter. Fee is \$80 per reservation. If cancellation for the truck is received less than 30 days before the reservation, 50% of the Fee will be deducted before a refund is issued.

Food Truck must be parked in the designated location. A sign must be posted at the Food Truck indicating food provided is for the **private event participants only** and not offered or available to the general public.

The Food Truck must be self-contained and require no electricity, water, or other service from the Parks Department.

Food Truck vendor must provide liability insurance in the amounts of \$2 million per occurrence, \$3 million aggregate. Port of Hood River must be listed as additionally insured and the Certificate holder.

Users shall not permit any waste left or damage to park property by action of the Food Truck Vendor, its agents or employees. No shrubs, trees or other vegetation may be damaged, moved or otherwise disturbed as a result of permitted activity. Food Truck Vendor shall repair, replace or restore the permitted area so that it is free from evidence of food truck vendor's use.

It is also the responsibility of the Food Truck Vendor to protect and clean any surface that is unprotected on the reservation day. Should Parks staff be required to clean the designated space, the user will be charged for the service. **The easiest way to protect the surface from damage is to lay down a protective ground cover, such as cardboard, plastic, or rubber mats. It is best to cover the entire surface of the food truck space.**

Food Truck must be licensed by the County and authorized to operate in the City of Hood River, Hood River County.
